Short bio:

David Crystal is honorary professor of linguistics at the University of Bangor, and works from his home in Holyhead, North Wales, as a writer, editor, lecturer, and broadcaster. He read English at University College London, specialized in English language studies, then joined academic life as a lecturer in linguistics, first at Bangor, then at Reading, where he became professor of linguistics. He received an OBE for services to the English language in 1995. His books include *The Cambridge Encyclopedia of the English Language* and *The Stories of English. A Little Book of Language*, and *Begat: The King James Bible and the English Language* were published in 2010 and *Internet Linguistics: A Student Guide* and *The Story of English in 100 Words* in 2011. *Spell it out: the story of English spelling* is due out in September 2012. He was consultant for the British Library 'Evolving English: One Language, Many Voices' exhibition (November 2010 to April 2011), and author of the accompanying book, *Evolving English*.
